The board reflected of 2017: Summer University, Research Book, ANSE Journal. We set priorities for 2018 - Quality and Education of Supervision, both based on the policy plan. We approved guidelines for using the ANSE LOGO which will soon be shared with national associations. And we brainstormed about developing a communication strategy and new ANSE project.

Call for articles

ANSE Journal 2nd edition is under preparation.

The theme of this edition is:

"Politics and social responsibility" - effect and influence in and through supervision / coaching
The social / political situation in Europe is changing. What influence does supervision / coaching have on the development? How political / socially critical should / can supervision be? How do social and political developments influence supervision and coaching?
A very broad, but a very current topic. Similar to the topic of the first issue of the ANSE journal "quality", this topic also offers many starting points. Theoretical reflections, philosophical inputs, case descriptions etc. ; Perhaps there is a philosophical approach that is being heavily debated in your country, perhaps there are colleagues who work supervisorial with politicians, surely there are many examples of how social and political developments find their way into the supervision of individuals, groups and teams.

Length of the articles:

Theoretical part: 2000-3000 words/ 14.000 – 21.000 signs incl. punctuation marks.
Practical part: 1000-2000 words/ 7000-14000 signs incl. punctuation marks.
Every article has to be written in English.
